## Questions

- What is a caravan?
- What colour is the Jackson's 4WD truck?
- What **holiday activities** did the children in the story like to do?
- What do **you** like to do on holiday?
- What sort of things does a handyman do?
  - \* What is the **family cat's name**?
    - **How** did you find the cat's name?
    - What is **corrugated iron**?
    - Can you think of other things corrugated iron might be used for?
    - Why did Dad make the longdrop only four feet deep instead of eight?
- 'Feet' is an old measure. Find out how deep that is in centimetres (you can use a calculator).
  - \* What made Mum unhappy?
    - What did she want Dad to do?
    - What does 'all that work, it took its toll' mean?
  - \* Name some things the Jacksons stored in the longdrop.
  - Why did they put things in there?
- What do you think **your family might store** in a longdrop?







'When nature calls (as you well know), you really need a place to go.

- Make up 4-6 questions about the story for other/younger children. Activities \* Pretend it's your dad who blew up the longdrop. Tell the class about
  - This story is based on a true story. Think of a funny thing that has it as a 'Show and Tell' talk.
    - happened when you were on holiday. Write a story or a poem about it. Remember a poem doesn't have to rhyme.

Make a safety poster about handling matches. For example, 'When using matches, NEVER ...' You could make a funny list too, for example,

Make a coloured paper collage picture of your family on a

Colour-in the picture from the book (next page).

## Additional activities for older children

- Make a Wordfind using words from the story.
- \* Find pictures of how caravan shapes have changed over the years. Make a timeline. You could include cars and tent designs too.
- With a friend (or group), make a 3D model of the Jackson's holiday camp. You will need a base card, coloured card, paper, maybe small boxes, scissors, paint, sellotape/masking tape. Make the caravan, the water tank, maybe the striped deck chairs and OF COURSE the longdrop. Maybe someone has a model 4WD car and/or some people to add to your model.
- \* Discuss Why do people like holidays? Do we really need them? You could hold a debate arguing about the pros and cons of taking a holiday.
- Write out instructions on 'How to build a longdrop'. List all the equipment and materials you might need. Give details of construction. Include some pictures or diagrams. (You may need a little advice from a builder, handyman or Google?)
